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What is Near Me / Attend Anywhere?

Near Me / Attend Anywhere is a video consulting service for clinical appointments. Near Me / Attend Anywhere appointments take place primarily in your home. Your healthcare professional will see you via a video link.

How do I get an appointment?

Near Me / Attend Anywhere appointments are usually booked in advance, just like many other clinical appointments. You may receive a letter, or an email or telephone call with the date and time of your appointment.

When you next see or speak to your healthcare provider you may be asked if you want to use Near Me / Attend Anywhere for your next appointment. We would also encourage you to ask if it is possible for you to attend your next appointment via video link if you feel it would be right for you.

Benefits of Near Me / Attend Anywhere

Benefits of Near Me / Attend Anywhere can be reduced travel; reduced time away from home, work or school. Video consultations make it easier for you to have a member of your family or carer with you who may not have been able to travel to your appointment with you.

Video call security

Near Me / Attend Anywhere uses secure video consulting, which has been approved as private and confidential by NHS Scotland. Attend Anywhere calls are not recorded.

Is Near Me / Attend Anywhere right for me?

Near Me / Attend Anywhere is appropriate for many types of appointments, but it is not right for every person or suitable for every health condition. Near Me / Attend Anywhere cannot be used if you are having a procedure or hands-on care. Your healthcare professional can advise on whether Near Me / Attend Anywhere would be suitable for you.

If you prefer to travel to hospital, your local clinic or GP surgery for some appointments that's fine, you can choose if you want to opt in or out of using Near Me / Attend Anywhere .

Near Me / Attend Anywhere at home

To be able to use Near Me / Attend Anywhere at home, you need:

- A reliable internet connection (broadband or mobile)
- A device for making video calls, such as a tablet, smartphone or computer with webcam
- The Google chrome web browser or Safari web browser when using an Apple device.

The first time you use Near Me / Attend Anywhere we suggest that at least 30 minutes before the time of your appointment you go to <https://www.nhsaaa.net/services-a-to-z/near-me-attend-anywhere/> and use the link to test your internet connection and equipment.

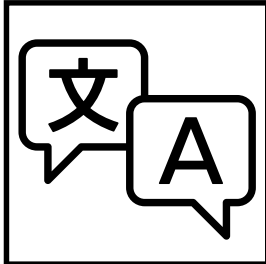
